- Theme color based on your Enterprise profile
- Your library's location, contact information, and website home page
- Links to your databases and digital collections web pages, if available
- Links to your social media pages (e.g. Twitter, Facebook, Instagram)
- RSS feed of your events, if available, or a link to your events web page
- Search configuration including your eResource Central (eRC) collections including Overdrive, Hoopla, Axis 360, and RB Digital

The app will be available for a period of testing before go-live, when you can make sure the information we have configured for you is correct. SWAN will also work with SirsiDynix to provide training in the administrative features of the app, so that your library can manage your own app.
