- Library staff simply place items in outgoing bin




When to use a RAILS Label vs. ILDS Label

Use an ILDS label






The ILDS Label

Use the <u>Illinois Library Delivery</u> <u>Service (ILDS) label</u> for:

- Academic libraries that are ILDS delivery locations
- RAILS libraries outside your delivery hub
- Libraries in the Illinois Heartland Library System (IHLS)
- Chicago Public Library





Drivers use iPads to collect delivery data.





Library Requirement



Delivery Count

- Required by the Illinois State Library four times per year.
- Physically hand count items.
- Enter daily counts using the online form on the RAILS website.
- Count outgoing items and outgoing bins for the day. (Outgoing = picked up by driver on that day)
- Important not to use totals from your ILS.
- Accuracy matters! Counts are audited to ensure accuracy.






Materials are exchanged 5 nights per week between RAILS hubs and IHLS.
