  - a. Background
    - i. Most also work at the reference desk. Some also have a book club.
  - b. How many Outreach patrons does your library currently serve?
    - i. SCD- over 200
    - ii. BLD- 130
    - iii. ESS-115
    - iv. WMS- 30-34
  - c. How many senior facilities/schools does your Library currently serve?
    - i. General: Some use their own cars for delivery. Most of their libraries children's department does their own outreach. SCD let us know that a bookmobile can costs anywhere from 300,000 to half a million dollars.
    - ii. ESS- 2 (her and helper do delivery) They also do art, crochet, rug hooking card making button making needle punch and run a literary film club. They go to the facilities every other week.
    - iii. BLD-6 They also have 3 book clubs. Rack at the track- they have a book shelf at the train and they donate books. They also have senior fairs, and they visit their facilities every other week.
    - iv. SCD-10 (also just them) 2x a month
    - v. WMS-4 (volunteers) Also run book discussions for MaysLake. They visit their facilities once a month
    - vi. INS -4 (volunteers) They go every other week to their facilities.
