 - a. Brookfield begins tagging in January, new building starting in spring
 - b. Ahren Sievers joining as RFID User Group chair

 - e. Does migration from one vendor to another require retagging?
 - i. Not so long as it's sharing the data model (28560-2)
 - ii. Oak Park needed to reprogram their tags to support the current model

- i. Nothing noted, seems to work or is invisible to other libraries
- g. Are lending-library security tags a concern for patron checkouts?
 - i. Most borrowing libraries are accommodating, they just reattempt checkout to ensure bit is cleared and/or item is checked out
- h. Theft bit unification will be important for a unified data model
- 4. Discussion of RFID RFP Template
 - a. Overview of existing RFPs
 - b. Create framework for template
 - i. RFID Basic (Tagging, Self Check, Gates, etc.)
 - ii. RFID Plus (Basic plus addition of AMH)
 - c. To include in template: Will providing vendor perform tagging for the library?
 - *i.* Purchasing & tagging are primary focuses for template
 - d. SWAN to investigate: MobileCirc with RFID Socket Mobile device
 - *i.* Can this device both read and interact with the tag?
 - *ii.* SWAN will plan a "show-and-tell" to share this device with groupparticipating RFID libraries
 - e. Can alternative tag vendors be listed somewhere?
 - *i.* Library Supply Solutions noted as alternative
 - *ii.* Pricing over tags discussed
