

Background

- Clarity Task Force identified our discovery platform as a source of dissatisfaction in the membership, especially around relevancy
- Aspen was the highest-scoring platform in the Discovery Platform Evaluation, conducted with DUX February 2019 – March 2020
- Exploratory research and testing with Aspen began in mid-May 2020, in partnership with ByWater Solutions



Relevancy – Known Item Searches

- In the July 2020 meeting, DUX and cataloging advisory compared keyword searches in Aspen and Enterprise
- Used a set of patron personas to develop keywords
- Recorded the position of known items in the results (e.g. 2nd result)
- Recorded the number of relevant results in a topic search (e.g. 10/25)

Relevancy scores for known item searches (position in results)

Measure	Enterprise	Aspen
Mean	11.5	1.9
Median	2	1
Below 1st	66.7%	39.4%
Below 5th	25%	6.1%
Below 10th	19.4%	0%


Measured precision by ranking the top 5 results in the search




EBSCO SWAN Group Purchase Update


Advocating security and privacy with our vendors

 Ensuring 3rd parties are transmitting data and authenticating in a secure manner, following current standards and acceptable protocols

Ensuring our development follows industry standards

- Use of SSL certificates to ensure proper form encryption
- Reducing the "hops" of PII (Personally Identifiable Information)
- Encrypting transmission of this data





SWAN Securities Initiative

- Associated Projects:
 - Sunsetting of external SIP2 connectivity by end of 2021, transition vendors to:
 - TLS-wrapped SIP2 OR
 - Web Services OR
 - OpenAthens
 - Exploration of TLS-wrapped (encrypted) internal WorkFlows and SIP2 connections
 - SonicWall End of Life (EOL) hardware upgrades for SWAN-managed libraries
 - Prices range from \$500 (smaller installations) to \$2,000 (high-end installations)
 - We will reach out to affected libraries directly to plan/budget





Changes/Impact

Immediate - Now

- Policies are appearing in Symphony (GSD, ROD, WVD)
- Model policies for item type consolidation (e.g. video)
- Added to SWAN group in OCLC (ILL requests deflected)

During Migration (Dec)

- Off-line during bibliographic database reindexing (targeted for: Dec 5-6)
- Assistance from SWAN member library staff as reallife experts (rely on expertise of user/advisory groups)

Post Migration

- First production use of BLUEcloud Acquisitions – will help development training, documentation, and procedures
- By Jan 2021, full resource sharing
- Consistent use of transit labels
