Aspen pilot phase

Pilot library commitments

- 2-3 staff members (pilot leads) to weekly meetings
- Pilot lead staff time for research assignments and configuration responsibilities
- Library staff time for trainings and patron support in Aspen
- Release Aspen beta on the library website and potentially other channels

Primary Roles & Testing Areas

Public Services Lead

- Responsibilities in readers advisory and/or collection development, regularly works with the catalog to place holds and assist patrons
- Materials requests
- Masquerade mode
- Browse categories
- Placards

Cataloging Lead

- Available to cataloging libraries only
- Sideloaded (e.g. Kanopy)
- Grouping and ungrouping records

Web/Communications Lead

- Manages the library website
- Theme
- Contact, hours, library information
- Spotlights
- Placards

Proposed Timeline

Milestone	Target Dates	Notes
Kickoff	December 2020	Following SWAN 100 Go-Live
Pilot lead training	December 2020	Take place at weekly meetings
Beta catalog configuration	December 2020 – January 2021	Completed by pilot leads with assistance from SWAN staff
Library staff training	January 2021	Training for all pilot library staff to prepare for supporting patrons using Aspen
Beta launch	February 2021	“Get a sneak peek at the new catalog” - Enterprise is still primary catalog, but Aspen is available to curious patrons
Research activities	February 2021 – April 2021	Could include interviews, surveys, usability testing, desk observations, time-capture screen recordings, and other methods – remote or in-person if safe.
Configuration and development	February 2021 – April 2021	Ongoing with research activities
Full member go-live	May 2021 – January 2022	Libraries would be scheduled in cohorts to go live together
Enterprise retirement	April 29 th , 2022	Enterprise no longer available to patrons or staff
