### **SWAN Circulation Advisory Group**

#### CHARGE

The Circulation Advisory Group is a 9-member advisory group that meets quarterly. Meetings are held four times a year on the third Wednesday of the month. The Advisory Group members serve two-year terms on a rotating basis. Advisory Group members may be called to volunteer as members of strategic task forces. This group will take part in discussions led by SWAN and will bring forth resulting recommendations to the SWAN Executive Director.

All discussions and research topics are guided by the following principles:

- Consensus building leads to constructive progress
- Consortium-wide perspective is prioritized over individual library procedures
- Patron experience guides recommendations
- Cooperation between other Advisory Groups creates a better consortium

#### **2021 FOCUS**

Annually, focal topics will be selected to assist SWAN leadership in addressing strategic direction and tactical planning. Topics of importance in calendar year 2021 include:

- Consolidation of item types for a more consistent staff and patron experience in interlibrary loan and reciprocal borrowing
- Review of messaging driven by circulation transactions
- Development and review of online training
- Patron management, including growth in digital-only and school/student users
