## Group A – Aspen Administration tools

User Group: Library staff

Need/problem: Better manage lists, spotlights, and browse categories

Ideas

1. Ability to sort by author in lists
2. Better image management for placards, resizing, etc.
3. Browse category group labels
4. Expiration of lists for browse categories
5. Scrolling in browse categories admin is annoying

## Group B – Purchase suggestions

User Group: Library staff

Need/problem: Address patron purchase suggestion requests in a timely and efficient manner

Ideas

1. Filters that direct the request/email to specific staff
2. Within Aspen, ability to limit requests to a specific selector via sort or filters (can work with #1). After initial staff member assigns the request to a selector or collection (hidden to patron).
3. Email notification when a request is made, ideally going to several email addresses.
4. Ability to change limits on number of requests (per particular time periods).
5. Possible limit or check on previously requested materials (might backfire).
6. Include notes about specific formats (info about periodicals, or blu-ray or DVD confirmation, etc.)
7. Secondary drop down for DVD/Blu-ray to choose one or doesn't matter after movie/tv series/etc.
8. Better training and set up. Suggested practice on workflow.
9. Check with WorldCat that pulls in more information, similar to mailing address checks: "do you mean this address?" (might backfire)
10. Add question to request link to item

## Group D - ISBNs

User Group: Library Staff

Need/problem: Find ISBN information in grouped records search results to copy and paste into other staff tools

Ideas

1. When you click Show Editions, show the ISBN in the Edition column instead of the edition statement
2. Display ISBNs on the home page
3. Use masquerade mode for holds, instead of copying and pasting the ISBN into WorkFlows to place a hold
4. Hyperlink the ISBN list in the grouped record detail, so you can click on an ISBN and get to the record
5. List only 1-3 ISBNs and click a link to access the rest of the ISBNs

When you click edition, show the ISBN

Replace edition with ISBN
