
SWAN Office Move



Quarterly Billing

Learn about SWAN centralized billing for Reciprocal Borrowing material losses and how your bills are structured. On a quarterly basis, SWAN processes paid Collection Fees and material replacement costs for Reciprocal Borrower and Inter-Library Loan losses.

Documentation

How Billing is Determined

Transactions that occur within the SWAN system associated with item bills are included in the Quarterly Billing. Item Information, Item Status, Bill Reason, and User Information drive the quarterly credits and debits.

How to Read and Reconcile the Quarterly Billing

How to make sense of the Quarterly Billing reports and understand your credit or debit total.

Bills by Year

Current and historic SWAN Quarterly Billing 2017 to present.

Example Bills

The Quarterly Billing Summary sheet will have 12 columns of debits and credits. These 12 are derived from pivots on 6 distinct base reports.


